

ORDER NO. 16-06

**SEQUOIA NATIONAL FOREST
WESTERN DIVIDE RANGER DISTRICT
TULE RIVER CANYON GLASS CONTAINER PROHIBITION**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Western Divide Ranger District of the Sequoia National Forest. This Order is effective from May 16, 2016 through September 30, 2016.

1. Possessing or storing alcoholic beverages in glass containers in the Tule River Canyon Glass Container Prohibition Area, as described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.58(bb).
2. Possessing or storing food in glass containers in the Tule River Canyon Glass Container Prohibition Area. 36 CFR 261.58(cc).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.


The Tule River Canyon Glass Container Prohibition Area is comprised of three segments.

The first segment is 600 feet on both sides of the Middle Fork of the Tule River from the point at which the Middle Fork of the Tule River intersects with the boundary of the Sequoia National Forest in Section 32, T20S, R30E, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian (MDB&M), then east to the point at which the Middle Fork of the Tule River intersects with the North Fork of the Middle Fork of the Tule River in Section 26, T20S, R30E, MDB&M.

The second segment is 600 feet on both sides of the North Fork of the Middle Fork of the Tule River from the point at which the North Fork of the Middle Fork of the Tule River intersects with the Middle Fork of the Tule River in Section 26, T20S, R30E, MDB&M, then northeast to the Wishon Campground in Section 18, T20S, R31E, MDB&M.

The third segment is 600 feet on both sides of the South Fork of the Middle Fork of the Tule River from the point at which the South Fork of the Middle Fork of the Tule River intersects with the Middle Fork of the Tule River in Section 26, T20S, R30E, MDB&M, then southeast to the Moorehouse Fish Hatchery in Section 30, T20S, R31E, MDB&M.
