CANYON CREEK COMPLEX FIRE CLOSURE ORDER

MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the area described in this order and depicted on attached map within the Malheur National Forest, State of Oregon, County of Grant from May 13, 2016, and in effect until rescinded.

- 1) It is prohibited for motorized travel on a road within area closure described in Appendix A. **36CFR261.54 (e)**
- 2) It is prohibited for motorized cross country travel within the fire area described in Appendix A. **36 CFR 261.56**

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2) Any Federal, State or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 3) An employee of the Forest Service when performing their official duties.
- 4) Owners or lessees of land within the closure area.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571)





Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and 261.50 (b) the following prohibitions are terminated effective immediately:
