On 05/20/2016, at 10:30 AM, sealed bids will be opened in the Yreka, California for the Beaver Hazard Fire Salvage sale. This sale is located in T46N, R9W, sec 2-5; T47N, R8W, sec 19, 30, 31; T47N, R9W, sec 12-14, 22-27, 31-36; T47N, R10W, sec 36; MDM; Siskiyou County. Timber sale Contract 2400-6 will be used. The termination date for this sale is 12/31/2016.

Measurement of the estimated quantities will be made after felling. The total estimated quantity on this sale is 1,140 MBF. The Forest Service encourages potential bidders to make their own inspection and estimate prior to bid submission. The Forest Service makes no representation, warranty, or guarantee of the accuracy of the following quantity estimates:

This sale includes surface replacement deposits, provision C5.35#. Deposits for surface replacement will be collected at a rate of \$3.07 per mbf, in addition to the road maintenance deposit of \$0.28 per mbf.


