ROAD AND AREA CLOSURE
Portion of NFSR #474/674 (South Fork Salmon River Road)
For Public Safety - 4 Summit Challenge Bike Event

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the National Forest System road as described in this order, within the administrative boundaries of the Krassel Ranger District, Payette National Forest and Cascade Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect from **July 30, 2016, at 07:30 A.M.** and shall remain in effect until **July 30, 2016, at 2:30 P.M.**

1. Using any type of motor vehicle on the road. **36 CFR 261.54(a)**
2. Using any type of stock on the road. **36 CFR 261.54(b)**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Any Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Volunteers and support staff as authorized by the 4 Summit Challenge event organizer.

ROAD CLOSURE DESCRIPTION

National Forest System (NFS) Road #474 becoming #674 (aka South Fork Salmon River Road) is closed to motor vehicles and Stock and is described as beginning at the junction of NFS Road #474 and County Highway #22 (Warm Lake Highway), located within Township 15 North, Range 6 East, Section 1 and continuing Northerly, becoming NFS Road #674, to the Camp Creek Campground, located within Township 18 North, Range 6 East, Section 15.

The described roads are within the Krassel Ranger District, Payette National Forest and Cascade Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise Meridian, Valley County, Idaho.

PURPOSE


The segment of roads, as described above, must be closed to all motor vehicle and stock access to provide for public safety during the 4 Summit Challenge bike event.

IMPLEMENTATION


1. This Order will be in effect from **July 30, 2016 at 7:30 A.M.** and shall remain in effect until **July 30, 2016 at 2:30 P.M.**
2. A map identifying the above-described areas and road is attached to and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders/notices for the above-described roads or portions thereof.
5. Assessment of Need and Enforcement Plan
Krassel Ranger District – Payette National Forest
Cascade Ranger District – Boise National Forest

1. Background.

For the previous six years the 4 Summit Challenge (4SC) organizing committee has successfully planned and implemented the 4 Summit Challenge bike event. In prior years the course began in Cascade and was an out and back that covered the two mountain passes along Warm Lake Road.

In anticipation of road construction that will occur on the Warm Lake Highway during the 4 Summit Challenge event on July 30, 2016, the 4SC Committee needed to find an alternative route for the event and has proposed using the South Fork Road (Forest Service Road #474/674) crossing the Boise NF and onto the Payette NF. Use of this road will require a closure order to ensure the health and safety of the event participants.

2. Intent of Subpart B order.

This temporary road closure is for all motorized and equestrian use on the South Fork Salmon River Road #474/674 from the junction at the Warm Lake Highway north to the Camp Creek Campground.

3. Enforcement Plan.

On the ground signing and temporary barricades will be installed at the beginning of the route (at the junction of the South Fork Road and the Warm Lake Highway), at the Camp Creek Campground and Trailhead (just past the Reed Ranch Airstrip), and on all information boards throughout the South Fork Salmon River recreation corridor campgrounds and trailheads.

On site signing to advise the public of the road that is closed will be posted. Social media as well as information published in local newspapers will be used to disseminate information related to this closure. On site FS law enforcement and administrative personnel will make compliance contacts as needed.




