**SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FORESTS
HEBER-KAMAS RANGER DISTRICT**

TEMPORARY AREA CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) **the following acts are prohibited** on National Forest System Lands as described in this Order, all within the Heber-Kamas Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forests. This Order is in effect starting June 4, 2016 through June 16, 2106.

1. **Going into or being upon any area** as described below and shown on the attached map. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

Strawberry Valley area located in Township 3 South, Range 12 West, far eastern portion of Section 22, all of Section 23, western half of Section 24, northeastern portion 25 and Northern half of 26 and 2.05 miles of Mud Creek road (Forest Service road #70150) beginning at the intersection of Forest Service Road #70150 and West Side Road (Forest Service Road #70131), Township 3 South, Range 12 West, Section 24 road closure ends at the intersection of Mud Creek Road (Forest Service Road #70150) and (Forest Service Road #70572), Township 3 South Ranger 12 West, Section 22, all within the Uintah Special Meridian, as shown on attached map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the Order is to provide for public health and safety while the Utah Army National Guard are conducting military maneuvers on and in Strawberry Valley and while using heavy equipment to re-construct portions of Mud Creek Spur 1 road (Forest Service road #70292), and resurfacing Mud Creek road (Forest Service road #70150) to improve drainage and disperse camping areas.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)].
