

Oder No. 03-16-03
Eldorado National Forest
Sunset Campground Bald Eagle Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) & (b), and to protect nesting bald eagles, the following acts are prohibited on the Pacific Ranger District of the Eldorado National Forest. This Order is effective from May 21, 2016 through August 15, 2016, and from January 1, 2017 through August 15, 2017.

1. Going into or being upon the Sunset Campground Closure, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.53(a).
2. Using any type of vehicle on Forest Road No. 12N35E and Forest Road No. 12N35G within the Sunset Campground Closure, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 CFR 261.54(a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (2) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
