C6.315# - SALE OPERATION SCHEDULE. (6/94) Unless otherwise agreed to between Purchaser and Forest Service, Purchaser's Operations shall be performed in accordance with the following schedule:

Subdivisions	Operation Conditions	Purpose
All, except 20D, 20E, 22A	All operations shall occur only between September 24 and February 28 (inclusive).	Prevention of disturbance to Marbled Murrelet and Spotted Owl
20D,20E,22A	All operations shall occur only between June 1 and October 31 (inclusive) and shall occur between 2 hours after sunrise and 2 hours before sunset between June 1 and September 23, inclusive unless otherwise agreed to by Forest Service.	Prevention of disturbance to Marbled Murrelet and Spotted Owl  Reduction of sedimentation
All	Road construction, reconstruction, and obliteration (temporary and specified) are allowed only between June 1 and October 31, and shall occur between 2 hours after sunrise and 2 hours before sunset between June 1 and September 23, inclusive unless otherwise agreed to by Forest Service.	Prevention of disturbance to Marbled Murrelet and Spotted Owl  Reduction of sedimentation.
All	All instream culvert work is allowed between July 15 and September 30, inclusive unless otherwise agreed to by the Forest Service.	Reduction of potential impact to fish.
All	Requests for waiver of a timing restriction as stated in this Sale Operation Schedule shall be submitted in writing no later than 30 days prior to the effective date of the restriction. The Forest Service reserves the right to deny all waiver requests. Requests for waivers submitted later than 30 days prior to the effective date of the restriction will not be considered.	Allow Forest Service to process waiver request.
All	Haul operations that occur between November 1 and May 31 (inclusive) require a Wet Weather Haul agreement between the Purchaser and Forest Service. Some requirements may include additional silt fencing, straw wattles, straw mulch, spot rocking, and other forms of sedimentation reduction devices and/or purchaser self suspension of haul.	Reduction of sedimentation and potential impact to fish.
