


NATIONAL FOREST SPECIAL FOREST PRODUCTS

COLVILLE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.58 (t) the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System lands on the Colville National Forest as described below:

1. Possessing, storing, or transporting more than three gallons of any type of mushroom.
2. Mushrooms must be cut lengthwise while possessing, storing, or transporting three gallons or less.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 USC 551 And 18 USC 3559 and 3571)
