Fire preparedness meeting planned for Scott Valley

FORT JONES, CA – The US Forest Service announced plans for a “[Scott Valley Community Fire Season Preparedness Meeting](#)” to be held in Fort Jones on Friday, June 10. The event will include information booths and presentations focused on the 2016 fire season

Ted McArthur, District Ranger for the Salmon/Scott River Ranger District, extended an invitation to the meeting: “All community members and anyone interested in preparing for the 2016 fire season is welcome to attend. This is a good opportunity to come together, meet local people working to keep Scott Valley safe from fire, and get current information on wildfire management.”

The event will be held at the Fort Jones Resource and Event Center (REC) and begins at 5:00 PM with complimentary barbeque provided by the Etna Brewery and Tap House. Participants may visit the information booths and greet Smokey Bear. Presentations will begin at 5:30 PM.

The meeting has been organized by the US Forest Service (Salmon/Scott River Ranger District), CAL FIRE, Scott Valley Coalition of Fire Safe Councils, Scott Valley Fire Protection District, Fort Jones Fire Department, Etna Fire Department, the Wildfire Institute, and the Northern California Resource Center.
