Kisatchie National Forest Re-Opens Popular Sandstone Multiple-Use Trail

The popular Sandstone Multiple-Use Trail will reopen on May 27, 2016. The 35-mile-long trail was closed for the month of May due to excessive rainfall and subsequent flooding. “We had over 14 inches of rain in a 36-hour period on March 8,” explained Ranger, Mike Dawson. “Bridges and major parts of the trail had to be repaired due to erosion caused by the flooding.” The trail, which is enjoyed by many for its spectacular scenery, is a multiple use trail used by hikers, horseback riders, and ATV users.
