Nancy Creek Road Temporary Closure

Colville, WA - Forest Road 9500550 (Nancy Creek Road) will be temporarily closed at the Forest Service boundary for public and contractor safety during logging operations. The closure will be in place Monday through Friday and lifted during the weekends. Nancy Creek Road is located approximately 2.5 north of junction of state Highway 20 and U.S. Highway 395, northwest of Kettle Falls, WA. This temporary closure is effective immediately and is anticipated to last until June 15, 2016.
