

Closed areas in the National Forests and Grasslands in Texas

Due to storms and excessive rainfall, portions of roads, trails and recreation areas are closed. Forest visitors should always check their surroundings and be aware of hazardous road conditions and the possibility of falling limbs or trees.

Angelina National Forest

- Roads closed to all traffic: Road 302 and segment of Road 300

Davy Crockett National Forest

- Roads closed to all traffic: Roads 502A, 510B, 513 north of 521 to south of 558, 518A, 520 at Ratcliff Lake, 523, 527 between County Road 4690 and County Line Road, 533, 539, 560A, 563, 586, and 591A
- Roads closed except for those who need access to their property: Roads 553, 528B, 503, 505, and 511 is closed south of 560 and north of County Road 1155 and south of Hwy 7 to north of 527.

- Roads closed to all traffic: Segments of Roads 152, 181, 156
