TRAIL CLOSURE
(For Public Safety)

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (b) the following act is prohibited on the NFS Lands as described in this order, all within the administrative boundaries of the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect on **June 7, 2016 at 12:01 A.M.** and shall remain in effect until **September 15, 2016 at 12:01 A.M.**, unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.

1. Being on the trail. **36 CFR 261.55(a)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

TRAIL DESCRIBED:

National Forest System (NFS) Trail # 595 – That portion of NFS Trail #595 that parallels and is East of NFS Road #304A located in Township 5 N, Range 6 E, Section 6. Users will be detoured onto NFS Road #304A for approximately ½ mile.

The above described trail is within the administrative boundaries of the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

PURPOSE:

The portion of NFS Trail #595 as described above is closed to all users to provide for public health and safety due to a Timber Stand Improvement project. The project work includes tree felling and yarding of felled trees, which poses a hazard to trail users. Trail users will be detoured onto a ½ mile segment of NFS Road #304A.


IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect on **June 7, 2016 at 12:01 A.M.** and shall remain in effect until **September 15, 2016 at 12:01 A.M.**, unless rescinded earlier by the Forest Supervisor.
2. Maps (1) identifying the road closure are attached and made part of this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same or similar acts prohibited by this Order on the roads described in this Order.
