"Peekaboo Site" and NFSR 393.A
 Occupancy and Use Restrictions

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on National Forest System lands within the Leadville Ranger District of the San Isabel National Forest located within the NW1/4 of the NE1/4 of T. 12 S., R.82 W., Section 8, 6th Principle Meridian, Chaffee County, Colorado (the "Restricted Area") and on that part of National Forest System Road (NFSR) 393.A beginning 30 feet from its junction with NFSR 393 and ending at the road terminus (the "Restricted Road").

The Restricted Area is locally known as the "Peekaboo Site" and is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A. The Restricted Area is more particularly described as a portion of T12S R82W Sec.8 NW1/4 NE1/4 located primarily to the east and south of the terminus of NFSR 393.A consisting of approximately 5 acres.

The purpose of the Order is to protect public health and safety, and to prevent vandalism and looting.

PROHIBITIONS:

- (1) Going into or being upon the Restricted Area. 36 C.F.R. §§ 261.53(e) and (e)
- (2) Being on the Restricted Road. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e)


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the Order:

- (1) Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue group or fire fighting force, in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Persons owning the rights to the Leo Hatches Unpatented Mining Claim, or any agents of same with written documentation in their possession, executed by the unpatented claim owner, authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.


This Order is in effect for one (1) years from the date signed, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
