Warm Springs	WR-04B	Motorized Trail	N	Opens a previously gated road, popular area for non-motorized rec
Kitten Creek	WR-05	Motorized Trail	N	Opens a previously gated road, popular area for non-motorized rec
Little Warm Springs	WR-06	Motorized Trail	N	Only provides a very small loop, less than one quarter mile from FSR 554
Warm Springs Mountain	WR-07	Motorized Trail	Y	Provides a large effective loop, provides legal access to an area currently w/out it
Grandy Reservoir	WR-08	Motorized Trail	N	Proximity to riparian areas, crosses steep slopes, cost to build and maintain
Warm Springs	WR-09	Motorized Trail	N	Dropped because it conflicts with Plan mgmt direction for area to be summer non-motorized.
Warm Springs	WR-10	Motorized Trail	N	Crosses large expanse of open terrain presents compliance concerns
Bachelor Creek	WR-11	Motorized Trail	Y	Provides a large effective loop, connects FSR 554 to MT 14, crosses small portion of roadless
Long Creek	WR-12	Motorized Trail	Y	Provides an expanded loop, follows an existing road template
Warm Springs Mountain	WR-13	Motorized Trail	Y	Provides a large effective loop, provides legal access to an area currently w/out it
Long Creek	WR-14	Motorized Trail	Y	Provides an expanded loop w/ very minor amounts of construction
Upper Wind River	WR-15	Closure	Y	Road was for access to utility lines but lines are no longer there. Dead-end access with no dispersed camping sites present.
Long Creek	WR-16	Closure	Y	This is a duplicate road
Geyser Creek	WR-17	Closure	N	No known resource issues
Warm Springs Mountain	WR-18	Closure	N	No known resource issues
Bald Mountain	WR-19	Closure	N	No know resource issues
Union Pass	WR-20	Closure	Y	Dead-end route. No dispersed sites along this stretch. This will offset the roadless area mileage of WR-11.
Moon Lake Road	WR-21	Motorized Trail	N	Crosses large expanse of open terrain presents compliance concerns
Moon Lake Road	WR-22	Motorized Trail	N	Very short route, the overlook view can be seen from other locales along the road.
Moon Lake Road	WR-23	Motorized Trail	N	There are plenty of other dispersed camping sites in the vicinity.
Little Warm Springs	WR-24	Motorized Trail	N	Too soon to know what type of access will be needed for POW camp project.
Burroughs Creek	WR-25	Seasonal Closure (4/1 - 6/30)	Y	Closure dates will provide protection for the native road surface during the wet spring months.
Bear Creek	WR-26	Motorized Trail	Y	Current impacts to riparian and wetland areas, moving to lighter vehicles expected to reduce those impacts
Long Creek	WR-27	Motorized Trail	Y	Provides a large effective loop, follows existing road template for large portion of route
Long Creek	WR-27a	Closure	Y	With WR-27, no need for this short dead-end route that ends in a meadow where there would be compliance concerns
Moon Lake Road	WR-28	Motorized Trail	N	Crosses large expanse of roadless, open terrain presents enforcement concerns, wildlife concerns
Long Creek	WR-29	Seasonal Closure (4/1 - 6/30)	Y	Closure dates will provide protection for the native road surface during the wet spring months.
Castle Rock	WR-30	Motorized Trail	N	Dead end route that crosses large expanse of open terrain presents compliance concerns popular non motorized recreation area
Brooks Lake Creek	WR-31	Motorized Trail	N	Dropped because a large portion of it is w/in the Primary Conservation Area (PCA) which would require a corresponding decrease in road miles elsewhere.
West Fork Long Creek	WR-32	Motorized Trail	N	Desire is to close the routes in the area because of riparian/wetland issues as well as compliance concerns with the open country
Gap Lake	WR-33	Motorized Trail	N	Northern portion is w/in PCA, popular location for non-motorized recreation
Enos/Coyote Creek	WR-34	Motorized Trail	N	Would require opening up a gated road which was closed for wildlife concerns that have not changed.
Enos/Coyote Creek	WR-34A	Motorized Trail	N	Would require opening up a gated road which was closed for wildlife concerns that have not changed.
Enos/Coyote Creek	WR-34B	Motorized Trail	N	Would require opening up a gated road which was closed for wildlife concerns that have not changed
Crooked Creek	WR-35	Motorized Trail	N	Does not provide any increased public access to the existing system
Bald Mountain	WR-36	Motorized Trail	N	Would open up an area popular with non-motorized recreation. Doesn't provide any loop opportunities, Bald Mountain already has a road system around it.
Sheridan Creek	WR-37	Closure	N	Existing open road w/ no major resource issues. Popular motorized recreation area
Double Cabin	WR-38	Closure	N	Existing open road w/ no major resource issues. Popular motorized recreation area
Clint Creek	WR-39	Closure	N	Existing open road w/ no major resource issues. Popular motorized recreation area
West Fork Long Creek	WR-40	Closure	Y	Modified the proposal to close the portion of FSR 549 north of FSR 549.1C to eliminate some dead end routes and replace them with new loops
Parque Cr Meadows	WR-41	Closure	N	Existing open road, Popular motorized recreation area
Warm Springs Mountain	WR-42	Closure	N	Existing open road w/ no major resource issues. Popular motorized recreation area
West Fork Long Creek	WR-43	Closure	Y	Close proximity to riparian, dead ends in open terrain with compliance concerns.
Long Creek	WR-44	Closure	N	Existing open road w/ no major resource issues. Popular motorized recreation area
Warm Springs Mountain	WR-45	Seasonal Closure (4/1 - 5/31)	N	No known wildlife concerns
Geyser Creek	WR-46	Seasonal Closure (4/1 - 5/31)	N	No known wildlife concerns
