**PRESCRIBED FIRE AREA CLOSURE
Monument Peak**

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited in the area described in this order, on the Richfield, Ranger District, Fishlake National Forest.

1. To go into or be upon the area described below which is closed for the protection of public health and safety. [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempted from the prohibition contained in this Order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the use that is otherwise prohibited by this Order. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(d)(1)]
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer; or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)]
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

Closed area entails

- Closure begins at Christensen Springs Forest Service Road 068, T25 S, R2W. Sec 13.
- Closure continues south and east north of Forest Service Road 068 to Forest Road 076, T26S, R2W. Sec 24.
- Closure goes east north of Forest Road 076 to the Forest Boundary, T26S R1W Sec 28.

- Closure then turns north following the forest boundary to T25S, R1W, Sec 8, roads that are closed along this line are Forest Road 1161, at T26 S., R1W, Sec 22, Forest Road 1162, at T26 S. R1W Sec 10, Forest Road 079, at T26S R1W Sec 3.

- Closure then turns west for two miles to south west corner of T25S, R 1W, Sec 18
- Closure then turns north ¾ mile along T25S, R1W, Sec 18 terminating at the beginning of the road closure at Christensen Springs, Forest Service Road 068.


PURPOSE/DURATION:

This order is temporary and is intended for public safety during prescribed fire operations.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This order will be in effect when signed at the point of restriction, beginning June 7, 2016, and shall remain in effect until June 21, 2016 or until rescinded.
2. A map identifying the areas that may be restricted is attached and made part of this order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or Imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)].

5. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order in the areas covered by this order.
