Cabin in the Woods

The Lone Cone Cabin is a great destination for an overnight getaway or a week-long hunting trip. Built in 1936, this rustic cabin is available year round. Located 24 miles southeast of Norwood, Colorado, the facility can be accessed in the summer and fall by passenger vehicle or 4WD, depending on conditions. Spring and winter access is by snowmobile, skis, or snowshoes along a 12-mile route.

Cabin Amenities

The cabin has:

- 2 bedrooms with a total of 6 twin beds and mattresses
- Summer: Running water with 1 flush toilet and 1 shower; Winter: Visitors melt snow for water and there is an outhouse just a short walk from the cabin.
- No potable water so bring water or a water filter.
- Electricity for lights and appliances
- Refrigerator, oven, microwave oven, woodstove, cookware, dishes, and utensils.
- Garbage bags, dish soap and sponges,, toilet paper, and firewood are provided.
- Bring your own food, potable water (or filter), sleeping bags, pillows, bath towels, and head lamp or flashlight.
