The Tom Martin Fire Salvage Sale is located within T45N, R11W, Sec 9, 14-16, 22, 23; MDM; Siskiyou County. The Forest Service will receive sealed bids in public at Yreka, California at 10:00 AM local time on 06/14/2016 for an estimated volume of 699 MBF of Douglas Fir sawtimber, 50 MBF of Incense Cedar sawtimber, 94 MBF of Ponderosa Pine sawtimber, 407 MBF of Sugar Pine sawtimber, and 1287 MBF of White Fir sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the sale area an unestimated volume of Salvage Douglas Fir sawtimber, Salvage Incense Cedar sawtimber, Salvage Ponderosa Pine sawtimber, Salvage Sugar Pine sawtimber, and Salvage White Fir sawtimber that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Interested parties may obtain a prospectus from the office listed below. A prospectus, bid form, and complete information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale, and submission of bids is available to the public from the Klamath National Forest Supervisors Office.
