

ORDER NO. 06-10-00-16-08
STAY LIMITS
ROGUE RIVER-SISKIYOU NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for equal camping opportunities by any person or group and for the protection of natural resources, the following act is prohibited within the boundaries of the Rogue River – Siskiyou National Forest as described below and shown in attached maps Exhibit A through Exhibit F. The Order is effective beginning June 1, 2016 and ending on May 31, 2018, unless rescinded sooner.

1. **CAMPING** by any person or group, within the boundaries described below and identified in Exhibit A through Exhibit F maps, for more than 14 days within a 45 day period. All developed campgrounds and dispersed camping sites including fee and non-fee sites within the described boundaries are included. 36 CFR 261.58(a)
2. Camping in violation of a posted sign. 36 CFR 261.58(e).

As defined in 36 CFR 261.2, camping means the temporary use of National Forest System lands for the purpose of overnight occupancy without a permanently-fixed structure.

Except where private lands are involved, the closure order boundary is ½ mile from either sides of:

1. Upper Rogue River from the Forest boundary at Prospect (section 20, T. 32 S., R. 3 E.) to Rogue Gorge Interpretive Site (section 3, T. 31 S., R. 3 E.) (High Cascades Ranger District)
2. Wagner Gap Area – County Rd. 557 from the Forest boundary (section 34, T. 39 W., R. 1 E.) to the intersection with FSR 2250; FSR 2250 from intersection with County Rd. 557 to intersection with FSR 200/205; FSR 2250-205 and FSR 2250-0215. (Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District)
3. Bull Gap Area – FSR 2080 from the Forest boundary (section 22, T. 40 S., R. 1 E.) to the northern boundary (section 2, T 40 S. R, 1 E.) (Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District)
4. Brownstone Area - FSR 1030 to the intersection with FSR 1030-500; FSR 1030-500 to O'Connell Creek. (Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District)
5. Carberry Area – County Rd. 777 from the intersection of County Rd. 859 to the intersection with FSR1015. (Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District)
6. Sturgis Fork Area – FSR 1015 from the intersection of County Rd. 777 to the intersection with FSR 1010-500. (Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District)
7. Applegate River – FSR 1040 from the intersection with County Rd. 777 to the intersection of FSR 1035; FSR 1050 from intersection with FSR 1040 to Forest boundary (section 16, T. 41 S., R11 W.) (Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District)
8. Flumet Flat Area – County Road 788 from the Forest boundary in section 5, T. 40 S., R. 4W to the Forest boundary (section 8, T. 40 S.; R. 4W.); FSR 1095 from the intersection with County

Rd. 788 to the end of FSR 1095-760; FSR 1095-350 from intersection with FSR 1095 to end of road. (Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District)

9. Squaw Creek Area – County Road 959 from intersection with County Rd. 859 to intersection with FSR 1075; FSR 1075 from intersection with County Rd. 859 to Forest boundary (section 2, T41 S., R 10 W.) (Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District)
10. Taylor Creek/Briggs Valley Area(s) – FSR 25 from Forest boundary (section 13, T. 35 S., R. 7 W.) to Forest boundary (section 24, T 37 N., R. 8 W.) (Wild Rivers Ranger District)
11. Spalding Pond Area- FSR 2524, FSR 2524-045, FSR 2524-046, FSR 2524-048, and FSR 745. (Wild Rivers Ranger District)
12. Illinois River/Briggs Creek Loop – FSR 4103 from intersection with FSR 4201 to intersection with FSR 4105; FSR 4105 from intersection with FSR 4103.
13. Eight Dollar Area - FSR 4201 from Forest boundary (section 29, T. 38 S., R. 8 W.) to intersection with FSR 4201-029; FSR 4102-029 from intersection with FSR 4201 to intersection with 4201-929; FSR 4201-929; FSR 4201-910 from intersection with FSR 4201-929 to end of road.
14. East Fork Trailhead – FSR 5820-011 from Forest boundary (section 15, T. 41 S., R. 5 E.) to California border (section 15, T. 19 N., R. 5 E.) (Wild Rivers Ranger District)
15. Oregon Mountain Botanical Area –FSR 4402 from the Forest boundary (section 27, T40 S., R4 E.) to intersection with County Rd. 316. (Wild Rivers Ranger District)
16. Grayback Area – State Highway 46 from Forest boundary to the intersection with FSR 4612. (section 30, T. 39 S., R. 6 E.)
17. Eden Valley Area – FSR 3348 from the Forest boundary (section 11, T. 32 S., R 10 W.) to intersection with FSR 33. (Powers Ranger District)
18. Elk River Corridor – FSR 5325 from the Forest boundary (section 7, T. 33 S., R. 14 W.) (Powers Ranger District)
19. Rogue River and Coquille River Corridors – FSR 33 from the Forest boundary at Lobster Creek (section 31, T. 35 S., R 13 W.) to the Forest boundary near Elk Creek Falls (section 6, T. 32 S., R11 W.) (Powers and Gold Beach Ranger Districts)
20. Bear Camp – FSR 23 from the Forest boundary (section 12, T. 34 S., R. 10 W.) to intersection with FSR 33. (Gold Beach Ranger District)

21. Woodruff/Red Flat Botanical Area – FSR 3313 from intersection with FSR 33 to intersection with FSR 3680; FSR 3680 to Forest boundary (section 18, T. 37 S., R13W.) (Gold Beach Ranger District)
22. South Fork/Packers Cabin Area(s) – FSR 1376 from the Forest boundary (section 31, T. 39 S., R. 12 W.) to the intersection with FSR 1909; FSR 1917 from the Forest boundary (section 33 T. 38 S., R. 12 W.) to the Kalmiopsis Wilderness boundary (section 19, T. 38 S., R. 11 W.) (Gold Beach Ranger District)
23. Ludlum House/Panda Ridge Areas – FSR 1108 from the intersection of FSR 1107; FSR 1107 from the Forest boundary (section 10, T. 41 S., R12 W.) to the intersection with FSR 1376. (Gold Beach Ranger District)
24. Packsaddle Area - FSR 1107-230 from intersection of FSR 1107 to Sourdough Trailhead. (Gold Beach Ranger District)
25. Illinois River/Oak Flat – County Rd. 450 from intersection with FSR 33, FSR 450-271, FSR 450-272, FSR 450-273 emanating from intersection with County Rd. 450. (Gold Beach Ranger District).

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.


A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest



 Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest



Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest**





Camping Restrictions



 Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest


