Outreach Notice Seeking Individuals for a Civil Engineer Technician Position

The Apalachicola National Forest will be advertising a full-time year-round GS-0802-5/7/9 Civil Engineering Technician position in the near future. The incumbent will perform field surveys to gather information to create designs. Surveys may be rough using a hip chain or tape, hand level, and compass, or they may be more complex and require the use of survey equipment. The incumbent will design forest roads, culverts and bridges, structures, and various other projects, create sketches and develop layouts, construction details, and installation drawings, compute quantities and make cost estimates, draft the final plan drawings, and prepare project specifications. The incumbent will also assist with facilities maintenance projects.

The incumbent will inspect timber sale road construction and public works construction projects, and will be expected to become certified as an Engineering Representative (ER) and Contracting Officers Representative (COR) and administer construction, maintenance, and timber sale contracts by the time they reach the GS-9 level. The work will include a mix of field and office work, and the field work will include working in rough terrain with exposure to a wide range of weather conditions, and will include working alone in the forest.
