


Emily Lake

Features

- 11 campsites
- Drinking water
- Boat landing
- All campsites located on an undeveloped lake shore overlooking beautiful 26 acre Emily Lake
- Good fishing for northern pike, crappie, perch, and panfish



Accessible features include:

Vault toilet facilities, interpretive trail at nearby Round Lake Logging Dam and fishing pier at nearby Newman Lake



Location

Emily Lake Campground is located on Forest Road 1178.


- From County Highway 70, drive north on FR 509 for 3.1 miles to FR 142. Turn right (east) on FR 142 and drive 0.2 mile to FR 1178, turn left (north) on FR 1178 and follow road into campground.

Campsite Capacity


Campsite capacity may not exceed 4 vehicles and 8 people.

- Vehicle capacity limit includes both wheeled camping unit and vehicles

Operation of all ATVs & UTVs are prohibited in campground

Description

This rustic facility is located on Emily Lake which is 26-acres in size. Drinking water and a vault toilet are available. Each of the 11 campsites has a parking spur, fire grill, and picnic table. A boat landing provides access for canoeing, swimming, and fishing. Emily Lake supports a good panfish population.

Campground Fees

Individual Campsite fee is \$12, or \$6 with use of Interagency Senior or Access Pass. Interagency Pass discount applies only to the fee for the campsite physically occupied by the pass holder, not to any additional fee or campsite(s) occupied by members of the pass holder's party.

Firewood Closure Order

Our firewood closure order prohibits the possession, storage, or transport of any firewood that originates from more than 25 miles from your campsite. Firewood certified by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Transportation and Consumer Protection can originate from more than 25 miles from National Forest destination. Both certified firewood and Kiln-dried, untreated/unpainted/unstained/construction/dimensional lumber that is free of any metal or foreign substance is approved. Pallet boards are not approved.
