

ORDER NO. 16-05-779
EMERGENCY CLOSURE
KLAMATH NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Happy Camp District of the Klamath National Forest. This Order is effective from June 9, 2008, until the fire is fully suppressed.

Being on the National Forest System roads listed below and shown on the attached map.

1. Forest Road No. 15N19 (Pony Peak Road), beginning from its intersection with 15N24 then continuing westerly to its terminus.
2. Forest Road No. 15N30 (Bear Peak Road).
3. Forest Road No. 15N28 (Dry Lake Road).
4. Forest Road No. 14N39 (Pony Peak Ridge Road).

36 CFR 261.54(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.






Forest Order No 16-05-779 Klamath National Forest
