**TRAIL CLOSURE**

**ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50(b) the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest Service Roads and Trails, as shown on the attached map, within the Bonners Ferry Ranger District of the Idaho Panhandle National Forests. These restrictions are in addition to those general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A, become effective **June 13, 2016**, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

1. **Prohibited to go into or be upon any area closed for the protection of Public Health and Safety. [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)]**
2. **Being on or using Trail #268 within T62N, R2W Sections 17, 18, 19 and 20, and T62N, R3W Sections 13 and 24. [Title 36 CFR 261.55 (a)]**

**It is prohibited to go into or be upon any area (trail) which is closed for the protection of public health or safety.**

This closure is necessary for public safety due to road work and harvest activities that will occur on access routes to Trail # 268. This closure becomes effective on Monday, June 13, 2016 and will remain in effect until rescinded or revoked.

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

1. Persons with specific written authorization for the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official emergency duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Contractor and his personnel in the performance of their duties.

**RATIONALE:** These restrictions are for **PUBLIC HEALTH and SAFETY** due to roadwork and harvest activities that Hancock Forest Management is conducting on their land. The Two Mouth Lakes trailhead and the first 1.5 miles of road and trail are located on Hancock Forest Management property, on which logging activity and log trucks will be hauling.

**PENALTY:** Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C 3559 and 3571)

**NOTIFICATION:** A copy of this order shall be posted in the Forest Supervisor's Office, each District Ranger's office and other appropriate locations as prescribed under Title 36 CFR 261.51.
