ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50(b) the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest Service Roads and Trails, as shown on the attached map, within the Idaho Panhandle National Forests. These restrictions are in addition to those general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A, become effective **June 13, 2016**, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

1. Prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the protection of Public Health and Safety. [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)]

Being in the Settler's Grove of Ancient Cedars

Being on or using Forest Service Road 805 northwest of the intersection with Forest Service Trail 526 in T50N; RSE; Sec. 7.

Being on or using Forest Service Trail 162 southwest of the intersection with Forest Service Road 270 in T51N; RSE; Sec. 28.

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

1. Persons with specific written authorization for the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official emergency duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Contractor and his personnel in the performance of their duties.


RATIONALE: Because this area is of special interest to the public and receives a relatively high level of recreational use, the closure is being established to protect public safety due to fire activity from the 2015 fire season and associated hazards such as fire damaged trees and unstable trail conditions in the area.

PENALTY: Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C 3559 and 3571)

NOTIFICATION: A copy of this order shall be posted in the Forest Supervisor's Office, each District Ranger's office and other appropriate locations as prescribed under Title 36 CFR 261.51.
