Title II Funds will be used by Tooele County to make repairs to Forest Road 005 on the west road shoulder by the stream that feeds Vernon reservoir. Recent storm events have taken out the fencing and created a hazard on the clear zone of the road shoulder. The purpose of this project is to repair the damage to the road, road shoulder, and re-construct the fence to properly drain water runoff from future storm and weather events while minimizing sediment to Vernon Creek.

Project objective is to restore and reconstruct the road side bank and right of way clear zone to provide a roadway that is safe for the traveling public.
