

# North 16 Stewardship Contract Highlights

**Stewardship End Result Contracting** – Please see next page for a listing of the stewardship projects. Credits earned as stewardship projects are completed are used to off-set the price of stumpage released in the Payment Units in this Contract.

- **Contract Area:** From Kenton, MI, go north on Forest Highway (FH) 16 for approximately 18.5 miles. Sale lies east of FH 16; From Highway M-38 at the junction with FH 16, go south on FH 16 for approximately 1.25 miles. Sale lies east of FH 16; For Payment Unit 9: From Highway M-38 go 2 miles east of the junction with FH 16, turn south on China Road approximately 1 mile. Payment Unit 9 is in the southwest corner.
- The enclosed link is a list of potential vendors that may be able to accomplish service items included in this contract. This list does not constitute a comprehensive list of all available vendors nor does it imply Forest Service support or preference for these or other vendors. Contracting Officer shall not be obligated to authorize additional stewardship work items at any time if Contracting Officer determines that there is insufficient value of remaining designated timber to cover the value of additional stewardship work items
