Dear Prospective Bidder:

By August 1st at 04:30 PM, sealed offers along with accompanying technical proposals will be accepted at the Andrew Pickens Ranger District, Attn: Forest Service Representative, 112 Andrew Pickens Circle, Mountain Rest, SC 29664 for the AP Spy Rock IRTC. The FS-2400-13T contract will be used. The termination date for this contract is December 31st, 2019. This contract is located in Oconee County of South Carolina, the southwestern area of the Andrew Pickens Ranger District, within timber compartments 52, 56, and 57. Access is via US Hwy 76 to FR 748-1 (Spy Rock).

A pre-bid site tour accompanied by the Forest Service is scheduled for prospective bidders on Wednesday, June 29th, starting at 10:00 am at the Andrew Pickens District Office, 112 Andrew Pickens Circle, Mountain Rest, SC, 29664. There are 8.2 miles of specified road reconstruction included in this contract. Costs of \$85,023 for specified road reconstruction plus \$11,503 for engineering reconstruction services have been accounted for in the timber appraisal. These costs are required to be borne by the contractor. In accordance with 36 CFR 223.84, contractors meeting Small Business Administration (SBA) eligibility requirements have the option of turning back specified road work, in which case the Forest Service would bear responsibility for the specified road reconstruction. Timber rates would be adjusted accordingly. *See bid form page 3, block #18 and page 8, Instruction #9 for more information.*

There is an estimated 2.5 miles of temporary road construction needed to access the timber. Exact location and length of temporary roads is by mutual agreement. Constructed temporary roads are required to be obliterated and revegetated according to requirements of KT-GT.6.0.1#.

The estimated quantities in this contract have been determined prior to felling. The total estimated quantity on this sale is 8,168 CCF. The Forest Service encourages potential bidders to make their own inspection and estimate prior to bid submission. The Forest Service makes no representation, warranty, or guarantee of the accuracy of the following quantity estimates:

In addition to the timber removal component of this contract, there is one mandatory and three optional stewardship projects included in this contract. Your price proposal must include a bid price for all four stewardship work projects. The optional project items may be included into the contract at the discretion of the Contracting Officer after the contract is awarded. As this work is completed and accepted, stewardship credits will be applied to the timber sale account.

Offers will be evaluated on a best value basis and bidders must submit a technical proposal describing how stewardship projects will be completed. The technical proposal that is submitted will become a part



of the contract when the contract is awarded. A unit rate bid for each timber product is required as well as the per unit rate for completing each stewardship project. Offers will not be publicly opened or disclosed. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all offers. *See bid form page 6, Instructions To Offerors for more information.*
