The Forest Service will receive sealed bids in public at Yreka, California at 10:00 AM local time on 06/30/2016 for an estimated volume of 754 MBF of Douglas Fir sawtimber, 98 MBF of Ponderosa Pine sawtimber, 9 MBF of Sugar Pine sawtimber, and 386 MBF of White Fir sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the sale area an unestimated volume of Incense Cedar sawtimber that the bidder agrees to remove at a fixed rate. In addition, there is within the sale area an unestimated volume of Salvage Douglas Fir sawtimber, Salvage Incense Cedar sawtimber, Salvage Ponderosa Pine sawtimber, Salvage Sugar Pine sawtimber, and Salvage White Fir sawtimber that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate.
