### ORDER NO. OA-TIA-04-2016

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF 16 U.S.C., SECTION 551 AND 36 CFR 261.50(a) AND (b), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT THE FOLLOWING ACTS ARE PROHIBITED WITHIN THE SEGMENTS OF THE **MOUNTAIN FORK RIVER** WITHIN THE OUACHITA NATIONAL FOREST.

#### **THE FOLLOWING ACTS ARE PROHIBITED TO ENSURE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY:**

36 CFR 261.58(cc). POSSESSION OF ANY GLASS CONTAINER AS PROHIBITED BY STATE LAW OR DISCARDING ANY GLASS CONTAINER IN A MANNER HARMFUL TO OTHERS.

The area is defined as: Those portions of the Mountain Fork River that are managed by the U.S. Forest Service as part of the Ouachita National Forest in LeFlore County, Oklahoma.

PURSUANT TO 36 CFR 261.50(e), THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS ORDER:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions 36 CFR part 261, Subpart A.

THIS ORDER WILL EXPIRE FIVE (5) YEARS FROM DATE OF EXECUTION
