GENERAL ORDERS

PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF 16 U.S.C., SECTION 551 AND 36 CFR 261.50 (a) AND (b), IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT THE PROHIBITIONS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH APPLY TO **ALL AREAS** WITHIN THE OUACHITA NATIONAL FOREST, UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED, UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

FIRE:

It is prohibited to:

- (1) Discharge or use of any kind of firework or other pyrotechnic device. 36 CFR 261.52(f)
- (2) Violate State burning or fire laws. 36 CFR 261.52(k)

SPECIAL CLOSURES

- (1) Possess or use metal detectors, electronic apparatus and devices for locating metal upon or within the boundaries of archeological, prehistoric or historic resources as defined in 36 CFR 261.2. 36 CFR 261.53(c)

ROADS:

It is prohibited to:

- (1) Use a road for commercial hauling without a permit or authorization. 36 CFR 261.54(c)
- (2) Operate any motorized vehicle on a National Forest System Road in violation of State Law. 36 CFR 261.54(d)
- (3) Operate any motorized vehicle on a National Forest System Road or any portion thereof that is posted as closed or closed by an earthen mound, gate or other object which a reasonable and prudent person would consider closed. 36 CFR 261.54 (e)

- (4) Operating any motorized vehicle carelessly, recklessly or without regard for the rights and safety of other persons or in a manner or at a speed that would endanger or be likely to endanger any person or property. 36 CFR 261.54 (f)

FOREST TRAILS:

It is prohibited to:

- (1) Be on the trail in violation of posted restrictions that are based on approved trail management objectives. 36 CFR 261.55(a)
- (2) Shortcut a switchback. 36 CFR 261.55(c)

WILDERNESS AREAS:

It is prohibited to:

- (1) Possess or use a wagon, cart or other mechanized vehicle (including bicycles) in area. 36 CFR 261.57(h)

This order applies to the following congressionally designated wilderness areas:

OCCUPANCY AND USE:

It is prohibited to:

- (1) Camp more than 30 consecutive days in the General Forest. 36 CFR 261.58(a)
 - (1a) Once the 30 consecutive day limit has been reached, the camp must be removed for fourteen (14) days and cannot be reestablished less than one (1) mile from the original campsite. 36 CFR 261.58(a)
 - (1b) Camp in the General Forest for more than 90 days within a calendar year. 36 CFR 261.58(a)

- (2) Be publicly nude. 36 CFR 261.58(j)
- (3) Possess or consume a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage by state law. 36 CFR 261.58(bb)
- (4) Fish in violation of posted instructions that are consistent with State fishing regulations. 36 CFR 261.58(v)
- (5) Hunt within a one-mile radius of the Ouachita Civilian Conservation Center. 36 CFR 261.53(e)
- (6) Use hang gliders except where permitted by Special Use Authorization. 36 CFR 261.53(e)
- (7) Hitch, tether, hobble, or corral a horse or other saddle or pack animal within 100 feet of any live, running stream. 36 CFR 261.58(aa)

OCCUPANCY AND USE (DEVELOPED RECREATION AREAS):

It is prohibited to:

- (1) Be in the area (or posted part of area) in violation of posted instructions associated with scheduled fish stocking events or construction or repair work and/or seasonal closures listed on the Forest's website. 36CFR 261.53(e)
- (2) Operate a vehicle in violation of the posted speed limit. 36 CFR 261.54 (d)
- (3) Camp in a single location (campsite within developed recreation area) for a period longer than fourteen (14) consecutive days. Campsite must be vacated for at least one week after the 14-day limit is reached. 36 CFR 261.58(a)
- (4) Use of a developed campsite by more than one (1) immediate family, or by a group of more than six (6) persons. Use of a designated double campsite by more than two (2) immediate families or by a group of more than twelve (12) persons. 36 CFR 261.58(f)
- (5) Park or leave a vehicle in violation of a posted sign. 36 CFR 261.58(g)

- (6) Possess a glass container on a swimming beach or within a designated swimming area. 36 CFR 261.58(cc)
- (7) Possess, park or leave more than two vehicles, except motorcycles or bicycles, per campsite unit. 36 CFR 261.58(i)
- (8) Camp outside designated campsites. 36 CFR 261.58(e)

OCCUPANCY AND USE (DAY USE AREAS and RIFLE RANGES)

It is prohibited to:

- (1) Be in the area before sunrise or after sundown 36 CFR 261.58(l)
- (2) Camp within the designated day use area. 36 CFR 261.58(e)
- (3) Park or leave a vehicle in violation of a posted sign. 36 CFR 261.58(g)
- (4) Stand or fish from the bridge on Forest Service Road 106 across Little Missouri River. 36 CFR 261.53(e)
- (5) Be in the area (or posted part of an area) in violation of posted instructions per seasonal closures listed on the Forest's website, ongoing construction or repair work, flooding conditions or potential for same, and other short-term public safety needs. 36 CFR 261.53(b)

WILDLIFE:

It is prohibited to:

- (1) Bait game species on the Ouachita National Forest by the direct or indirect placing of any salt, grain or feed that could serve as a lure or attraction on or over any area where hunters are attempting to take game. 36 CFR 261.58 (v)
- (2) Erect and leave temporary hunting stands in the General Forest area for a period more than fourteen (14) consecutive days in a row. 36 CFR 261.58 (v)
 - (a) Once the 14-day limit has been reached, stands must be moved and cannot be reestablished less than 200 yards from the original site.
 - (b) Stands must have owner's name and address permanently affixed.

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES:

It is prohibited to:

- (1) Possess a controlled substance unless such substance was obtained by the possessor directly or pursuant to a valid prescription or order from a practitioner acting in the course of a professional practice or otherwise allowed by Federal or State Law. Controlled substance means a drug or other substance, or immediate precursor included in schedules I,II,III, IV of V of Part B of the Controlled Substance Act (21 U.S.C. 812) or a drug or substance added to these schedules pursuant to terms of the Act.
- (2) Possess, store, or transport cannabis plant(s) or any substance derived from such plants. 36 CFR 261.58(t)

PURSUANT TO 36 CFR. SECTION 261.50(e) THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS ORDER:

- (1) Any Military, Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (2) Person with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (3) Wheelchair users when used as a necessary medical appliance (in Wilderness Areas).

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions at 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

THIS ORDER WILL EXPIRE FIVE (5) YEARS AFTER THE DATE OF EXECUTION
