Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests offices will close in observance of Independence Day on July 4

Springerville, AZ--June 29, 2014 – All Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests offices and ranger stations will be closed on Monday, July 4th in observance of Independence Day and will resume regular business hours Tuesday, July 5th from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

The Apache-Sitgreaves National Forests continue to be in Stage I Fire Restrictions. Campfires are only permitted at developed campgrounds listed in Exhibit B of Forest Order 01-16-590. If you plan to have a campfire we ask you to never leave your campfire unattended, have enough water and a shovel to put your fire out cold to the touch when you leave, and to please remember that fireworks are never allowed on National Forests.
