FOREST ORDER – EMERGENCY CLOSURE

Being on the trail or in an area

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest:

**Being on the trail (36 CFR 261.55a).**

**Going into or being in any area closed for the protection of public health and safety (36 CFR 261.53e).**

The purpose of this order is to ensure public health and safety during construction on Ditch Saddle Trail #4143 and within 1/8 mile buffer along the new construction segments: beginning at the junction of Norton Trail #4095 in T3N, R10W, Section 36 and continuing in a southwesterly direction for approximately 5 miles to the junction of Burnt Mountain Trail #4125 in T2N, R10W, Section 8 (see attached map).

This order will remain in effect from July 1, 2016 until October 15, 2016 unless rescinded sooner when construction is completed.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
