USDA Forest Service
Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit
Zephyr Shoals, Zephyr Cove Resort, and Nevada Beach Alcohol Prohibition

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit. This Order is effective on July 4, 2016.

Possessing a beverage which is defined as an alcoholic beverage under Nevada State law in the areas listed below and shown on Exhibits A, B and C.

- A. Zephyr Shoals
- B. Zephyr Cove Resort
- C. Nevada Beach

36 CFR § 261.58(bb).

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 26 1.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:


1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Operators and guests of the Zephyr Cove Resort, within the interior and fenced exterior areas of the Zephyr Cove Resort

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.


A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC § 551 and 18 USC §§ 3559, 3571 and 3581.
