ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50(b) the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest Service Roads and Trails, as shown on the attached map, within the Idaho Panhandle National Forests. These restrictions are in addition to those general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A, become effective **July 10, 2016**, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

1. Using any type of vehicle prohibited by the order. [Title 36 CFR 261.54 (a)]
2. Using or being on the trail. [Title 36 CFR 261.55(a)]
3. Prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the protection of Public Health and Safety. [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)]

When posted, Forest Road 271 from end of county road (2 mile road) to junction of FS Road 424 at Two Mile Saddle. Including Forest Trail 102.

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

1. Persons with specific written authorization for the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official emergency duty. Report all emergency access to the Coeur d'Alene River District Ranger as soon as possible.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Contractor and his personnel in the performance of their duties.


RATIONALE: These restrictions are necessary for **PUBLIC HEALTH and SAFETY during aviation operations while harvesting timber. Aircraft will be flying over these locations carrying sling loads of logs.**

PENALTY: Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C 3559 and 3571)

NOTIFICATION: A copy of this order shall be posted in the Forest Supervisor's Office, each District Ranger's office and other appropriate locations as prescribed under Title 36 CFR 261.51.
