**Golden Trout Fire
Emergency Trail and Road Closure**

PROHIBITIONS: Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following act is prohibited on the roads and trails as described in this order, all within the North Fork Ranger District, Salmon-Challis National Forest until further notice:

1. Being on a trail described below that is posted as closed. **36 CFR 261.55(a)**
2. Being on a road described below that is posted as closed. **36 CFR 261.54(e)**

EXEMPTIONS: Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIBED:

Road #113 is temporarily closed beginning where Road #113 intersects with Road #114 (T20N,R17E,Sec5) heading northwest to the Big Horn Crags Trailhead (T21N,R17E,Sec31).

Beginning in Section (T21N, R17E, Sec31) at the Big Horn Crags Trailhead where Trail # 6236 and Trail #6021 begin and heading northwest up Trails #6236 and #6021 to the trail intersection where Trail #s 6236, #6021 and 6038 come together (T21N, R16E, Sec36). Trail #6038 is temporarily closed from its intersection with Trail #s 6021 and Trail #6236 (T21N, R16E,Sec36) continuing southwest to where Trail #6038 intersects with Road #114 (T20N, R16E,Sec13). Trail #6070 is closed from the Big Horn Crags Trailhead (T21N, R17E,Sec31) to Golden Trout Lake (T21N, R17E,Sec 31).

The above-described area is within the proclaimed and administrative boundaries of the North Fork Ranger District, Salmon-Challis National Forest, Lemhi County, Idaho.

PURPOSE:

These closures are necessary to provide protection to forest visitors from the current fire safety hazards associated with the **Golden Trout Fire**.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until 07/31/2016 or when otherwise rescinded.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for a individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571 (b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in the above-described area.
