





Fire Affected Trails in the Pecos Wilderness

Española and Pecos Ranger Districts



ATTENTION
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These are sections where the trail has been erased by fire or floods, has or will have significant deadfall in severe burned areas, and where normal travel by foot or stock will be more difficult and dangerous than pre fire conditions. There may be other trails not shown on this map that may be just as difficult or dangerous due to other causes. All trails through burned areas tend to have a higher degree of danger from dead snags falling over the trail.
