

Order No. 11-16-04
Plumas National Forest
Jackass Bridge Emergency Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited on the Plumas National Forest. This Order is effective from April 9th, 2016 until December 31, 2017, or until the Jackass Creek Bridge is replaced.

Being on the Jackass Creek Bridge located on Forest Trail No. 6M40 at its intersection with Jackass Creek, T 24N, R 6E, Sec. 16, near Tobin, CA as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.53(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Persons with a contract from the Forest Service authorizing work on the closed road and area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent authorized by the contract.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions found in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
