

**Order No. 11-16-07**  
**Plumas National Forest Service**  
**Gold Lake Area Closure**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited on the Plumas National Forest. This order is effective from August 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016.

1. Being on Forest Road No. 21N61A from its intersection with 21N61, the Gold lake Campground Road, as shown on map Exhibit A.
2. Going into or being upon the Gold Lake Boat Launch Facility including parking area, boat launch, boat dock and pathways associated with the Gold Lake Boat Launch Facility, as shown on map Exhibit A.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Persons with a contract from the Forest Service authorizing work on the closed road and area are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent authorized by the contract.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions found in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
