

Order No. 11-16-01
Plumas National Forest
Emergency Road Closure

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited on the Plumas National Forest. This Order is effective from April 5th, 2016 through September 1 2016.

Being on Forest Road No. 21N16, from its intersection with Sly Creek Boat Ramp, T20N, R8E, Sec. 18, north to its intersection with Forest Road No. 22N24 and Forest Road No. 21N16, T20N, R8E, Sec 18, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Persons with a contract from the Forest Service authorizing work on the closed road are exempt from the prohibition listed above to the extent authorized by the contract.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions found in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
