



Order No. 19-16-06
USDA Forest Service
Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit
Carnelian Hazardous Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit. This Order is effective every day from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., July 05, 2016 through October 01, 2016.

1. Going into or being upon Unit 5 of the Carnelian Hazardous Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project, as described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within Unit 5 of the Carnelian Hazardous Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within Unit 5 of the Carnelian Hazardous Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons with a contract from the Forest Service authorizing work on the Carnelian Hazardous Fuels Reduction and Healthy Forest Restoration Project are exempt from the prohibitions listed above to the extent authorized by the contract.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.



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Exhibit A

The boundary of Unit 5 begins at the southeastern corner of Section 1, Township 16 North, Range 17 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, the continues 1,365 feet north along the eastern section line of Section 1, Township 16 North, Range 17 East, then continues 5,245 feet due west to its intersection with Forest Road 16N56, then continues 722 feet along Forest Road 16N56, then continues 869 feet southwest at a 201 degree angle, then continues southeast 338 feet at a 157 degree angle, then continues 624 feet southeast at a 94 degree angle, then continues 1,233 feet southeast at a 106 degree angle, and then continues 4,347 feet along the southern section line of Section 1, Township 16 North, Range 17 East back to the starting point.
