**ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR**  
**ORDER NUMBER 08-13-04-10-07**

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C., Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited within the specified area.

**SAM HOUSTON NATIONAL FOREST  
DOUBLE LAKE RECREATION AREA  
GROUP SITES**

- 1. USING A GROUP CAMPSITE WITH MORE THAT TWENTY-FIVE (25) PEOPLE. 36 CFR 261.58(f)**
- 2. OCCUPYING OR USING A GROUP RECREATION CAMPSITE OR PORTION THEREOF PREVIOUSLY RESERVED. 36 CFR 261.58(b)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C., Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited within the specified area.

**SAM HOUSTON NATIONAL FOREST

- 1. Discharging a firearm, air rifle or gas gun. 36 CFR 261.58(m)**
- 2. Hunting or trapping in this area. 36 CFR 261.58(v)**
- 3. Possessing or transporting any part of a green tree or plant.  
36 CFR 261.58(t)**
- 4. Entering or using a site or portion of a site closed to public use.  
36 CFR 261.58(b)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

**5. Using a campsite with more than eight (8) individuals except in Group Area. 36 CFR 261.58(f)**

**6. Operating a boat or canoe within the swimming area, delineated by buoys is prohibited. 36 CFR 261.58(k)**

**7. While in swimming area, hanging onto depth markers and floating buoys is prohibited. 36 CFR 261.58(k)**

**8. While in swimming area using devices such as tubes, floats, rafts, flutter boards, surfboards and toys is permitted only in designated shallow water wading area of DOUBLE LAKE. This area extends from the beach area to first string of buoys. 36 CFR 261.58(k)**

**9. Possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages on the beach and swimming area in accordance with Health and Safety Regulations are prohibited. 36 CFR 261.53(e)
