



## Northwest Forest Passes

Northwest Forest Passes and Interagency Passes are valid for all Forest Service operated day-use sites on the Deschutes National Forest and Newberry National Volcanic Monument.

Northwest Forest Annual and Day Passes can be purchased from Forest Service Stations\* or the vendors listed below.

- ◆ Northwest Forest Day Passes are \$5.00 per day.
- ◆ Northwest Forest Annual Passes are \$30.00 and are valid for one year from the date of purchase.
- ◆ Newberry National Volcanic Monument offers a three day pass for \$10.00 that is valid only on the Monument.



## Interagency Passes

Interagency Passes can only be acquired at Forest Service Stations listed below.\*

- ◆ The Interagency Annual Pass, Senior Pass, Access Pass, Military Pass, and Volunteer Pass are honored at all posted fee sites.



*Golden Age passes are still honored but can be exchanged, free of charge, if signature is faded beyond recognition.*
