

ORDER
SCOTT FIRE TRAIL AND AREA CLOSURE
KAIBAB NATIONAL FOREST
TUSAYAN RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. 551 and Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and/or (b), the following acts are prohibited in areas as described in this Order on National Forest System lands administered by the Kaibab National Forest, Tusayan Ranger District in Coconino County in the State of Arizona. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Being on a trail, 36 CFR 261.55 (a).
2. Being in an area, 36 CFR 261.53 (e).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and,
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

AREA DESCRIBED:

The Arizona Trail #101 closure begins at the Grandview Trailhead, and extends approximately 9 miles southeast to where it crosses Forest Road 310, north of Russell Tank. The area closure will start near the Grandview Trailhead, extending east and southeast, between Forest Road 307 and 310.

PURPOSE:

This order is needed for public safety due to the Scott Fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until July 31, 2016, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
