

**ORDER**  
**Arapaho and Roosevelt National Forests**  
**and Pawnee National Grassland**

**RESTRICTIONS ON DISCHARGING FIREARMS**

Due to extreme fire conditions, pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50(a), the following act is **prohibited** on all National Forest System lands in Boulder County in the State of Colorado.

This prohibition applies to the areas depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Discharging a firearm. 261.58(m)


**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a US Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer in the performance of an official duty.
3. Any person possessing a valid Colorado hunting license lawfully involved in hunting and harvesting game.
4. Persons discharging an air rifle or gas gun.

This order is in effect starting at 12:01 a.m. on July 11, 2016 and will remain in effect until rescinded.

Violation of these regulations is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. (16 USC § 551 and 18 USC §§ 3559 and 3571).
