
PURSUANT TO TITLE 36 CFR 261.50(a), I PROHIBIT THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS ON NATIONAL FOREST LANDS IN THE TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST:

1. CAMPING IN EXCESS OF FOURTEEN (14) DAYS OUTSIDE OF DEVELOPED CAMPGROUNDS PER RANGER DISTRICT, PER YEAR. 36 CFR 261.58(a).

PURSUANT TO 36 CFR 261.50(e)(1), THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE EXEMPT FROM THIS ORDER:

1. PERSONS WITH A WRITTEN PERMIT IN THEIR POSSESSION SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZING THE OTHERWISE PROHIBITED ACT.
