

PUBLIC NOTICE

TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST SUGAR PINE RESTRICTED USE AREA

Order No. 17-95-166

PURSUANT TO TITLE 36 CFR 261.50(a), I PROHIBIT ALL OF THE FOLLOWING ACTS ON NATIONAL FOREST LANDS OUTSIDE OF DEVELOPED RECREATION SITES IN THE SUGAR PINE RESTRICTED USE AREA AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1:

1. CAMPING. 36 CFR 261.58(e).
2. BUILDING, MAINTAINING, ATTENDING, OR USING A FIRE, CAMPFIRE, OR STOVE FIRE. 36 CFR 261.52(a).

THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES OF THE SUGAR PINE RESTRICTED USE AREA ARE AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1; GENERALLY DESCRIBED AS, 500 FEET FROM THE LAKE SHORE, RECREATIONAL FACILITIES, AND APPLICABLE ROADS.

THESE PROHIBITIONS ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS IN 36 CFR 261.


