

# PUBLIC NOTICE

## TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS FOREST ROAD #10 (SUGAR PINE ROAD)

ORDER NO. 17-95-171

PURSUANT TO 36 CFR 261.50(a) AND (b), TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLIC SAFETY DURING WINTER MONTHS AND SNOW REMOVAL OPERATIONS ON SUGAR PINE ROAD, THE FOLLOWING ACT IS PROHIBITED:

PARKING OR LEAVING A VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF POSTED INSTRUCTIONS. 36 CFR 261.58 (g).


(SEE EXHIBIT "A" FOR THE AREA SUBJECT TO PARKING RESTRICTIONS. THE RESTRICTION APPLIES FROM NOVEMBER 1 THRU MAY 1 OF EACH YEAR, AND PROHIBITS PARKING ON THE ROADWAY OR SHOULDERS WITHIN THE SNOW REMOVAL STAKES.)

THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE EXEMPT:

1. ANY FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL OFFICER, OR MEMBER OF AN ORGANIZED RESCUE OR FIRE FIGHTING FORCE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF AN OFFICIAL DUTY.
2. ANY FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL OFFICIAL INVOLVED IN SNOW REMOVAL OPERATIONS.


THESE PROHIBITIONS ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS CONTAINED IN 36 CFR PART 261.
