

PUBLIC NOTICE

TAHOE NATIONAL FOREST

SOUTH YUBA RESTRICTED USE AREA

ORDER NO. 17-95-175

PURSUANT TO 36 CFR 261.50(a), I PROHIBIT THE FOLLOWING ACT ON NATIONAL FOREST LANDS WITHIN THE SOUTH YUBA RESTRICTED USE AREA AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1:

1. CAMPING. 36 CFR 261.58(e).

THE EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES OF THE SOUTH YUBA RESTRICTED USE AREA ARE AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT 1; GENERALLY DESCRIBED AS:

Being within 1/2 mile of the Yuba River, beginning at the Washington Townsite and proceeding upstream to the center of Section 11, T.17 N., R.11 E., MDM. This restriction also includes portions of Washington Creek and Canyon Creek as Shown on Exhibit 1.

THESE PROHIBITIONS ARE IN ADDITION TO THE GENERAL PROHIBITIONS CONTAINED IN 36 CFR PART 261.


