Road Closure and Area Use Restriction Closure Order
For National Forest System Road (NFSR) 843 – Mosquito Creek Road
During Construction Activities Associated With The Rocky Mountain Natural Gas Pipeline And Mosquito Creek Road
Maintenance Project

Pursuant to 16 United States Code (U.S.C.) § 551 and 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the described portion of National Forest System Road (NFSR 843) located within the Rifle Ranger District, White River National Forest, Mesa County, Colorado (the "Restricted Road") and within ¼ mile of the Restricted Road (the "Restricted Area"). The Restricted Road and Restricted Area are depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A. Refer to the White River National Forest Summer Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) for additional summer use information and restrictions in the area.

The Restricted Road is further defined as follows:

National Forest System Road (NFSR) 843 - beginning at approximately Milepost 0.8 (crossing at Mosquito Creek) (NW ¼ of Section 3, T9S, R91W) and ending at approximately Milepost 3.1 (DCU 1 Well Pad) (NE ¼ of Section 35, T8S, R91W).

The purpose of this Order is to protect public health and safety during pipeline and road maintenance activities on and along NFSR 843 in the work zone depicted in Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Using a motor vehicle on the Restricted Road during the hours of 0500 (5:00 AM) Monday thru 1800 (6:00 PM) Friday of each week. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(a)
2. Camping in the Restricted Area during the hours of 0500 (5:00 AM) Monday through 1800 (6:00 PM) Friday of each week. 36 C.F.R. § 261.58(e)


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

This Order shall be in effect beginning upon the date of the signing of this order and continue until rescinded or until October 15, 2016, whichever event occurs first.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571
