

ORDER NO. 16-07
EMERGENCY CLOSURE
LOS PADRES NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited on the Santa Barbara Ranger District, within the Los Padres National Forest. This Order is effective from July 12, 2016 through December 1, 2016.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Sherpa Fire Closure Area described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on the National Forest System roads listed below and shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
 - a. Any National Forest System road within the Sherpa Fire Closure Area.
 - b. Forest Road No. 5N19, from Winchester Canyon Gun Club, then west to Refugio Pass.


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
